












<p><b>BAYREUTH</b></p> <p>This historical city was established as a margrave residence. All over the world, it is known for the well-established Richard Wagner musical festival. In this city tourists can find enchanting chateaus, historical houses and parks. In the very center they can admire the Margrave Opera building that is considered the most beautiful preserved Baroque theater in Europe, the New Chateau building with a garden decorated with statues and water surfaces, the Old Chateau building with a church, and finally the 'Wahnfried' villa that serves as the Richard Wagner Museum. Worth visiting is also the historical Hermitage enclosed with a chateau park. Bayreuth is a city of walks, shopping and composure.</p>	  	<b>950</b>

<p><b>NUREMBERG</b></p> <p>Nuremberg is a lively metropolis with the refined spirit of the Middle Ages. Every step you make, you will discover monuments to the city's history of more than 950 years. <p><b>REGENSBURG</b></p> <p>"This beautiful city has two faces: one of stone and one of water. Yet, when you look the Danube in the eye, both faces become one." Regensburg, a city of historical buildings, towers and monastic structures, will open in front of you in its full glory. You can admire its unique Stone Bridge – the oldest bridge in Germany built in the years 1135–1146. It became a model for many more bridges constructed all over Europe (London or Avignon) and most likely also for the Judith Bridge in Prague. Another interesting building is the Old City Hall with a tower from the 13<sup>th</sup> century and the hall of the German Reich where Bundestag used to hold its sessions. Undoubtedly, the city's dominant is St. Paul Cathedral that represents one of the leading works of the Bavarian Gothic. If you look at the points of its spires, you will see kings riding on horses, foolish maidens or gargoyles with animal or human faces. <p><b>MUNICH</b></p> <p>We will visit the metropolis of Southern Germany, the City of Munich, situated at the foot of the Alps on the crystal clear mountain river Isar. Munich. The third largest city in Germany is connected with many attributes – the beating heart of Bavarian economy or the capital of beer. The enjoyment of cultural and artistic activities can be sought in a broad variety of art galleries, museums, historical monuments and theaters. Since the very beginnings of Munich, the center of all events has been in Marienplatz Square that is dominated by the Gothic building of the Old City Hall and the New Gothic building of the New City Hall whose façade is decorated with the statues of kings, princes, dukes, allegoric figures and outstanding personal of Munich's history. You can hardly miss Maximilianstraße Street that combines the luxury and charm of Munich. The well-known, splendid boulevard is line with classy designer shops such as Gucci, Armani or Yves St. Laurent. From picturesque Františkovy Lázně, where we will be served refreshments, we will continue our trip to the historical town of Cheb. <b>THE CHATEAU AND BREWERY OF CHYŠE</b> The village of Chyšé lies approximately 40 kilometers of Karlovy Vary in the direction of Prague. The main decoration of the community is its chateau, the seat of the Lažansky House. History lovers can take a chateau tour that comprises three parts: chateau interiors, chateau cellars, and an exposure covering Karel Čapek's stay at this castle in 1917. Romantics are strongly recommended to go for a stroll in the chateau park. Gourmets should not miss the chateau restaurant and beer lovers should pay visit the chateau brewery where they can enjoy beer tasting. The beer of Chyšé is brewed according to old Bohemian recipes, using prime quality Bohemian and Moravian malts, Žatec hops, and natural sparkling water from the Doupovske Mountains. The local brewery produces three kinds of yeast beer 'Prokop' (light, amber and lager), each of them being available on tap or bottled. The bottled beer can be bought in an exclusive gift package. If you would like to learn more come and visit the Castle of Chyšé. If you are lucky, your tour will be guided by the chateau owner himself, i.e. by Mr. Vladimír Lažanský.	 13.00 – 17.00	500
<b>THE CHATEAU OF BEZDRUŽICE</b> Originally a Gothic structure, this fortress was reconstructed to a Renaissance chateau in the 16th century. In the years 1999-2004, its current owner carried out extensive reconstruction of the chateau. The project helped to preserve, amongst others, the Hall of Knights which hosts an exhibition of contemporary glass. The Little Parlor presents the life and works of the nobleman Kryštof Harant of Polžice and Bezdrúžice. On the premises of the former chapel, visitors can admire an absolutely unique glass nativity scene weighing more than 3500 kg. At the end of the tour you can buy original works of art of glass, glass fashion jewelry and small souvenirs.	 13.00 – 18.00	600
<b>PILSEN + BREWERY</b> We will visit the West Bohemian capital and tour the Pilsner Urquell brewery, where we will sample their world famous beer. After lunch at the 'Na spilce' brewery pub, we will tour the nearby Kozel hunting estate, located approximately 20 kilometers from Pilsen. This magnificent estate with its English style park ranks as one of the most unique neo-classical architectural landmarks in the Czech Republic. It is built in the style of Louis XVI.	 09.00 – 17.00	950
<b>THE CASTLE OF ČERVENÝ ÚJEZD</b> The building of this private unique castle was erected in the years 2001 – 2002 on a green field not far from Prague. The castle interiors host an extensive Czech rural museum, introducing workshops of traditional tradesman (black smith, miller, baker, wood carver, cooper, butcher, cartwright, grinder, shoemaker), small country rooms from various regions, a night hall, an armory or a chapel. There are also rooms fitted with historical instruments, tools, products and equipment that once belonged to our ancestors. Some of the exhibits are saleable. The meticulously kept gardens are occupied by numerous domestic animals. If you like daydreaming and history, good food and drinks, come and join us.	 13.00 – 19.00	750
<b>THE CHATEAU OF MĚLNÍK</b> Since Princess Ludmila, chateau Mělník has been occupied by the widows of the Czech Kings and Princes. It was not until the reign of Charles IV that the city became the dowry of the Czech Queens. Our lunch will be prepared in the chateau kitchens and later we will participate in a wine tasting in the 14th century cellars of the chateau, where an exhibit of wine making equipment can also be seen. Don't forget a bottle of the excellent Mělník wine as a souvenir of your travels.	 08.00 – 18.00	1200
<b>KUTNÁ HORA</b> Kutná Hora, a medieval center of silver mining, was the second richest city in the Bohemian Kingdom. The then riches of the city are still reflected in the diversity of architectural monuments and in the preserved structure of the city center. Kutná Hora has been on the UNESCO World Heritage list since 1995. When you take a stroll through Kutná Hora make sure you visit the Gothic cathedral of St. Barbara and Hrádek (Little Castle) – The Czech Museum of Silver, a medieval silver mine, Vlašský dvůr (Italian Court) – a former royal mint, a number of wonderful Gothic, Renaissance and Baroque town houses as well as unique stone fountain from the 15th century. You should not miss one of the most interesting burial places in the world – Kostnice (Charnel House) in a nearby town of Sedlec. The chapel is decorated with more than 40 000 human bones.	 08.00 – 18.00	1250
<b>AQUAFORUM IN FRANTIŠKOVY LÁZNĚ</b> The very center of the vast park in the picturesque town of Františkovy Lázně offers its visitors a water fun park inspired by Antique Roman baths. It provides huge water surfaces and attractions, indoor toboggan, chutes, restaurant and snack bar. Aquaforum, the world of water and relaxation, gives you a one-and-only opportunity to get some rest and relax and your children a chance to immerse in the world of water merrymaking.	 13.00 – 18.00	300
<b>WALDSASSEN</b> This German town lies at the Czech-German border, about 60 km from the city of Karlovy Vary. In the years 1682 – 1704, outstanding master builders and architects Georg Dientzenhofer and Abraham Leuthner erected one of the most monumental Baroque buildings there. The monastery basilisk from the turn of the 18th century boats about the largest temple and monastic crypt in Germany. Besides other points of interest, there is the organ of St. John, one of the biggest organs in Europe. You can also visit a monastery library, a jewel of woodcarving Baroque art, with a splendid decorated ceiling.	 13.00 – 18.00	500
<b>DRESDEN</b> Join us on a tour in the Saxon metropolis that is nicknamed Venezia on the Elbe by many. While walking in the Baroque center of the city that is considered one of the most beautiful cities in Europe make sure you take a view of its largest dominant, the magnificent Zwinger palace that is known for its abundant valuable art collections. You should not miss the New Renaissance building of Semper's opera and the Lutheran church of the Virgin Mary whose was completed in 2005 following 13 years of expensive repairs. Your eye will surely be caught by the wonderful view of the Elbe River from the esplanade terrace Brühl. Once your sightseeing of the historical district of Dresden has been finished you will have enough time to visit one of the numerous museums or galleries or go shopping on Prager Strasse, a well-known shopping district street.	 07.00 – 19.00	950
